

Inmate Commissary Funds

Gonzales County Sheriff's Office has transitioned to the online service **JailATM** as of August 7, 2017. JailATM is a service that allows family members of participating jails to send inmates money utilizing the website jailatm.com. When sending money, funds are made available to the inmates immediately after the credit card is processed. For both offline and online fund transfers, the individual must know the inmates S.O number (Sheriff's Office id number). In order to use the JailATM site, users must register for an account. After registering, users can easily transfer funds into the inmate's commissary account. If the users encounters any difficulties using these services, the JailATM site offers thorough instructions via the Contact Button at the bottom of the homepage. The website will offer video calls, gift packs and email services; however, we **do not** offer those services at this time.

It will no longer be necessary for your family or friends to mail you a money order or come to the office in person to drop one off. All transactions and deposits will be online.
