

Warrants

Gonzales County Sheriff's Office does not verify warrant information by phone. If you believe you have a warrant due to traffic violation or other criminal charges you may stop by the Sheriff's Office in person with a valid driver's license or other state issued picture identification. If you know the court that you believe your warrant is issued out of you may contact that court directly to see what steps need to be taken for resolution. If you know you have a warrant and would like to make arrangements to turn yourself in please contact Corporal Jared Brumme at (830)672-6524.

Misdemeanor Warrants

As of November 1, 2017 Gonzales County has begun a process to resolve **NON-VIOLENT** misdemeanor warrants. If you believe you have a misdemeanor warrant that is a non-violent offense you can make arrangements to resolve this matter by contacting Corporal Jared Brumme at (830)672-6524.

If arrangements are made, this matter can be resolved **WITHOUT ARREST** or JAIL TIME.
