

Sheriff's Fees - How much for service fees?

The fees that the Sheriff's Office may charge for service of various court process are designated by The Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts. The collection of these fees is mandatory. They may not be waived or set aside. Civil Process fees are set by Gonzales County Commissioner's Court. The fees are:

•Notices:

- Subpoenas\$100.00
- Summons\$100.00
- Writ of Attachment\$250.00
- Writ of Garnishment\$250.00
- Writ of Sequestration\$250.00
- Writ of Possession\$250.00
- Forcible Detainer\$100.00

Order of Sale
\$250.00

- For the first \$10,000 on or less 10%.
- An additional fee of 6% on the next \$15,000.
- An additional 2.5% of amounts more than \$25,000.

- When the money is collected by a Sheriff or Constable without a sale, half of the above rates shall be allowed.

- Justice Court Citation\$100.00
- All Other Courts Citations\$100.00

- Notice\$150.00
- Precepts\$150.00
- Writ of Execution\$250.00
- Injunctions\$150.00
- Temporary Restraining Order\$150.00
- Habeas Corpus\$150.00
- Catch Fee/Contained Area\$25.00
- Catch Fee/if Horse Used\$100.00
- County Fee Per Head\$25.00
