68A VIN INSPECTION VEHICLE AND TRAILER INSPECTION INFORMATION

If you are needing a 68A VIN Verification completed on a vehicle or trailer, it must be inspected by a Gonzales County Auto Theft Taskforce Deputy.

If you are trying to register a Homemade or Shop-built trailer, upon inspection you will need to bring the trailer along with a bill of sale if it was purchased or receipts showing you built the trailer.

If you are trying to register a Vehicle or Trailer with an assigned VIN number, you will need to bring the vehicle or trailer along with proof of ownership including a title or bill of sale. If the vehicle or trailer has been imported to the US from another country, you will also need to provide registration, entry, and customs declaration forms.

All vehicles and trailers must comply with state laws and display current or temporary registration. Temporary registration tags may be obtained from the Gonzales County Tax Assessors Office.

APPOINTMENTS

The Gonzales County Auto Theft Task Force Deputy conducts 68 A inspections. The inspections will be conducted by **Appointment Only**. The 68A Inspections Request form must be filled out and emailed to <u>rrodriguez@co.gonzales.tx.us</u> prior to the inspection. APPOINTMENTS ARE WEATHER PERMITTING. IF IT IS RAINING, INSPECTIONS WILL NOT BE COMPLETED AND YOU WILL NEED TO RESCHEDULE. Inspections will only be completed at our office as we do not make house calls for this service. You will be asked to wait inside the Sheriff's Office while the inspection is done.
